
Over the years, some questions never disappeared, and new questions arose

Environment – Economy – Europe + Euro – Elites: Crises where you look!







All theses crises have very similar roots

Market Failure	 Driven by perverse incentives, wrong signals Shortsighted, neglecting the future An outdated concept of growth and wealth
Govern- ment Failure	 Weak regulation, mainly due to laissez-faire ideology Captured by from strong lobbies, i.e. energy
Elite Failure	 Loss of values, bad examples, greed as a virtue Violation of simplest rules which our kids learn in kindergarten (<i>Clean up your dirt</i>)
All this adding up to	 Unsustainable behaviour of consumers, firms and governments → A world behaving like four-year-olds!






- Americans have never experienced real Socialism, perhaps that's why they get somewhat hysterical about it.

IN BOTH CASES:


- Protection of the weaker: members of society, future generations, or Nature







How about a price system that will finally tell the truth in all three dimensions?


- the economic truth:

Here some practical suggestions about what you and I can do

Read New York Times or Süddeutsche Zeitung

Don't vote for parties that ignore the climate threat or fight market based instruments. (If you prefer to stay in such a party, work to change their position.)

Watch your personal CO₂-balance

Drive more BMW (= Bike, Metro, Walk)

atmosfair Compensating air miles is a good idea (but no substitute for tickets taxes, ET or other strong tools)

Never forget: this is a political issue at first (an issue of personal ethics only in second or third place)

➤ Something's foul in this planet, not because people are bad, but because of failing institutions, ignorant elites, and misleading prices!
